



Lets talk about Selecting your population for a Population Health Management Program. There are five main selection options:

- Global such as every person in a geography, healthcare system, practice, health plan or employer health benefit.
- By disease state or condition such as persons with asthma, diabetes, cancer or pregnant.
- By specific product or service such as all persons on a particual r drug or class of drugs or those undergoing a specific surgical procedure.
- By cost or utilization such as those above a certain dollar threshold or perhaps with multiple ER visits.
- By risk level using Surveys or lab measures such as all persons with

Choosing a selection approach and then identifying all persons who fall within that option is a critical first step and can become very complicated.
